DIC to Participate in Paint India 2018, One of India's Largest Coatings and Related Materials Exhibitions

Tokyo, Japan—DIC Corporation announced today that it will participate, together with Singapore-based wholly owned subsidiary DIC Asia Pacific Pte Ltd and India-based DIC India Ltd, in Paint India 2018, which will take place from March 8–10, 2018, in Mumbai. Inaugurated in 1993, the event is one of India's premier forums for companies to disseminate and exchange information on coatings and raw materials used therein.

The DIC Group's Paint India 2018 booth will showcase a wide range of coatings and related products that comply with regional standards, with a focus on polymers and pigments.
